FAMILY CONVERTIBLE GLOVES / MITTENS
(TO KNIT)**

SIZES

Small: To fit Child's (6/10 yrs) palm.

Medium: To fit average Lady's palm.

Large: To fit average Man's palm.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Softee Chunky (100 g / 3.5 oz; 164 m / 180 yds)

PLAIN VERSION

Small (**Medium**-Large)

39046 (Grey Heather) 1 (1-2) **ball(s)**

STRIPED VERSION

Contrast A (39110 Dark Blue) 1 (1-1) **ball**

Contrast B (39742 Hot Blue) 1 (1-1) **ball**

Contrast C (39712 Hot Lime) 1 (1-1) **ball**

Set of four size 5 mm (U.S. 8) and 5.5 mm (U.S. 9) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

GAUGE

16 sts and 21 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

SOLID VERSION

Note: Size Small does not have separate fingers.

RIGHT GLOVE / MITTEN

******With set of smaller needles, cast on 24 (**28-34**) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles, 8 (**10-12**) sts on 1st and 2nd needle and 8 (**8-10**) sts on 3rd needle. Join in rnd. Mark first st with contrast thread.

Work in (K1. P1) ribbing for 1½ (**2-2**) ins [4 (**5-5**) cm].

Change to larger needles and knit 8 (**12-16**) rnds.**

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K13 (**15-18**). Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of rnd.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: K13 (**15-18**). Inc 1 st in next st. K2. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd.

5th rnd: K13 (**15-18**). Inc 1 st in next st. K4. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. 30 (**34-40**) sts.

Sizes M and L only: 7th rnd: K(**15-18**). Inc 1 st in next st. K6. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (**36-42**) sts.

All sizes: Next rnd: Knit.

Next rnd: K21 (**25-28**) sts. Slip last 8 (**10-10**) sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd.

Next rnd: Knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. 24 (**28-34**) sts.

Next rnd: (Marking rnd). K12 (**14-17**) [it may be helpful to draw a length of contrast yarn through the just knitted 12 (**14-17**) sts]. Place First marker. Knit to end of rnd. Place Second marker.

*****Size S only:** Knit 9 rnds.

Next 2 rnds: *K1. P1. Rep from * around. Cast off.

Sizes M and L only: Knit (**8-10**) rnds.

Next rnd: K(**14-17**).

To make 1st finger: Knit first 5 sts. Slip all but last 5 sts onto a thread. **Turn.** Cast on (1-2) st(s). **Turn.** Knit last 5 sts. Divide these (11-12) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit 5 rnds. Cast off.

To make 2nd finger: Slip next (3-4) sts from thread. **Turn.** Cast on 2 sts. **Turn.** Knit last (3-4) sts. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of first finger. Divide these (10-12) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit 5 rnds. Cast off.

To make 3rd finger: Slip next (3-4) sts from thread. **Turn.** Cast on 2 sts. **Turn.** Knit last (3-4) sts. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of second finger. Divide these (10-12) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit 5 rnds. Cast off.

To make 4th finger: Slip last (6-8) sts from thread. Pick up and knit 3 sts at base of third finger. Divide these (9-11) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit 4 rnds. Cast off.***

All sizes: Flap: Beg at Second marker, with larger needles, pick up 12 (14-17) sts across sts of marked rnd. Cast on 12 (14-17) sts. Divide these 12 (14-17) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd.

******Next 4 rnds:** K12 (12-18). (K2. P2) 3 (4-4) times.

Next rnd: Knit.

Knit 8 (11-13) rnds even.

Shape Top: 1st rnd: 1st needle: ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. **2nd needle:** ssk. Knit to end of needle. **3rd needle:** Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Rep last rnd until there are 4 (4-6) sts. Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 4 (4-6) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

Thumb: With set of larger needles, K8 (10-10) from safety pin. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of thumb. Divide these 10 (12-12) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit 7 (10-11) rnds even.

Next rnd: (K2tog) 5 (6-6) times.

Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 5 (6-6) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.****

LEFT GLOVE / MITTEN

Work from ** to ** as given for Right Glove / Mitten.

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K9 (11-14). Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of rnd.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: K9 (11-14). Inc 1 st in next st. K2. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd.

5th rnd: K9 (11-14). Inc 1 st in next st. K4. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. 30 (34-40) sts.

Sizes M and L only: 7th rnd: K(11-14). Inc 1 st in next st. K6. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (36-42) sts.

All sizes: Next rnd: Knit.

Next rnd: K17 (21-24) sts. Slip last 8 (10-10) sts onto a safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd.

Next rnd: Knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. 24 (28-34) sts.

Next rnd: (Marking rnd). K12 (14-17). Place First marker. Knit to end of rnd [it may be helpful to draw a length of contrast yarn through the just knitted 12 (14-17) sts]. Place Second marker.

Work from *** to *** as given for Right Glove / Mitten.

All sizes: Flap: Beg at First marker, with larger needles, pick up 12 (14-17) sts across sts of marked rnd. Cast on 12 (14-17) sts. Divide these 12 (14-17) sts onto 2 needles. Join in rnd.

Work from **** to **** as given for Right Glove / Mitten.

STRIPED VERSION

Note: When working in Stripe Pat, do not break yarn. Carry color not in use up inside of glove.

Stripe Pat

With A, knit 3 rnds

With B, knit 3 rnds.

With C, knit 3 rnds.

RIGHT GLOVE/MITTEN

With A and set of smaller needles, cast on 24 (28-34) sts. Proceed in Stripe Pat, work as given for Solid Version, noting that thumb is worked with A (not striped).
